What to Bring With You on the Day of Admission

- Prescribed medications you are currently taking only
- Financial documents requested Proof of residency (especially if your residency differs from your mailing address)
- Copy of SSI, SSD, or SSDI award letter Photo ID Birth Certificate Social Security Card Food Card
- Health Insurance Card Parole/Probation Information Small trash bag of alcohol-free hygiene products

1 - Shower shoes	1 crossword, word jumble, coloring book (unopened)

NO Markers, gel pens, or art supplies	NO Powder (i.e., baby, foot, etc.)
NO Food (individual wrapped candy permitted)	NO First Aid (i.e., Peroxide, medicated ointments, etc.)
NO Torch lighters	NO OTC Medications/Supplements (Tylenol, Benadryl,
NO Stuffed Animals	vitamins, etc.)
NO Bedding (i.e., pillows, blankets, etc.)	NO Electronic cigarettes
NO Luggage (i.e., bags, backpacks, etc.)	NO Electronic devices (i.e., tablets, radios/alarm clocks,
NO Purses	cameras, headphones, etc.)
